

Programme – Advanced Creative Studies Pathway – Contemporary Embroidery

This is a 360-hour programme that guides those who want to develop and strengthen their design and craft skills into professional and mature personal work. The participant will create a personal design folio, conceiving and developing ideas using sampling. They will go on to create a series of well-considered and excellently crafted items, consolidating robust designing and making practices. The programme requires 120 hours of independent investigation; the rest will be delivered through home study and / or classroom delivery, where gained knowledge is applied in practice.

How is the Programme organised? This is a 2-year programme leading to an ArtyBird Advanced qualification in Creative Studies – Contemporary Embroidery accredited by City & Guilds.

Pathway Information

This is a programme for makers who wish to explore their embroidery in depth and develop strong personal work.

- Design on paper and fabric, based on your theme, will inform and progress your work. This will be with strong guidance from your tutors.
- You will go on to identify your individual style and develop resolved samples and completed pieces.
- Looking at the work of other makers throughout the programme will inform your work as you progress.

You will start in September and meet for one weekend a month, for eleven months for 2 years.
