

Programme – Introductory Creative Studies Pathway – Machine Embroidery

This is a 30-hour programme that identifies and introduces skills in a craft area, alongside design. It can be used as a taster session for new participants or to extend skills for established makers, and starts from basics. The programme will be delivered through home study and / or classroom delivery, where gained knowledge is applied in practice.

This leads to an ArtyBird Introductory qualification in Creative Studies – Machine Embroidery accredited by City & Guilds.

Pathway Information

It concentrates on developing good embroidery skills through a range of samples and exercises that builds into a reference file.

The assignments include:

- How to make and use a range of automatic and free machine embroidery techniques. This will include a range of materials and tools.
- Simple design considerations, such as colour, shape, line and texture
- You will be introduced to a range of materials, tools and equipment.
- You will make an item.

Programme Delivery

You attend at Carnforth, Lancashire You will start in February and meet for one day a weekend for 6 days. Also offered as a Summer School.
